## **Surrey Police Transition**

Final Summary Report

This survey was conducted in July 2020 using a questionnaire with 9 substantive questions and 3 demographic questions. HR Data reports that Surrey Detachment had 794 regular members in total to whom invitations were sent. The survey received up to 754\* participants/respondents, which suggests an *overall response rate of 95%*, indicating overall highly representative results. 
## In reading the results below, please note the following:


