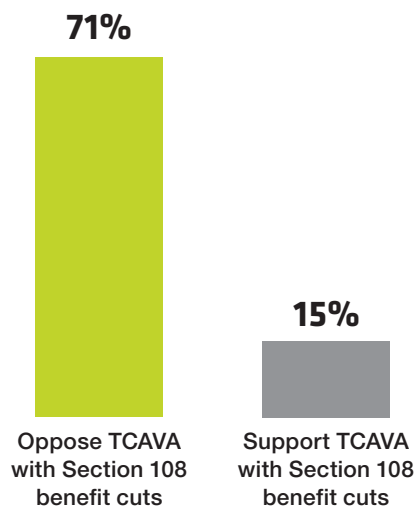




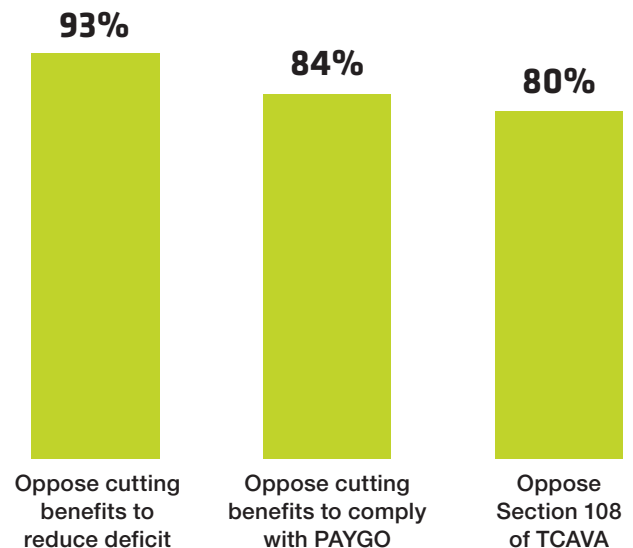

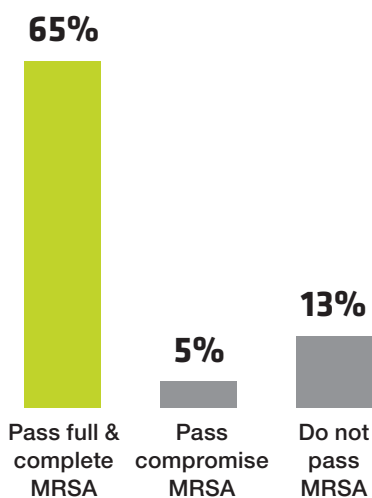

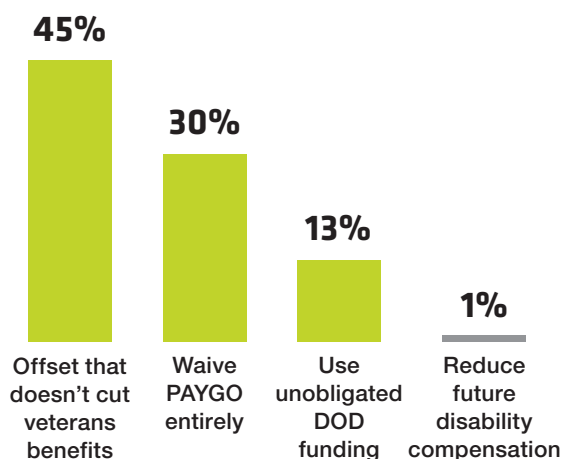
VETERANS OVERWHELMINGLY OPPOSE BENEFIT CUTS FOR BUDGET OR PAYGO COMPLIANCE



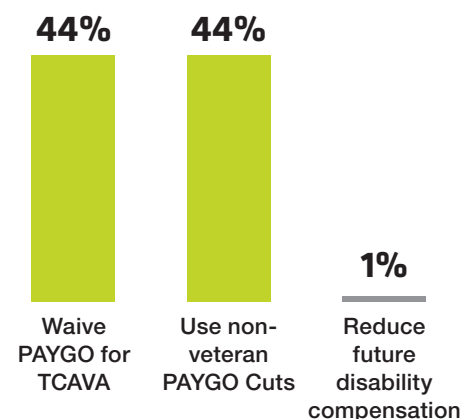

The survey was fielded through SurveyMonkey from August 31 to September 5, 2026, and received 4,254 responses, including 3,498 respondents who completed all substantive questions. The large response base provides substantial precision in describing the respondents' views. The principal findings were broadly consistent across geographic regions, service eras, DAV membership, disability-compensation status, and other measured respondent characteristics, with generally small differences among major subgroups.
