

Ultra Health Freedom of Speech Timeline

Ultra Health is denied sponsorship of the Albuquerque International Balloon Fiesta.

June 17, 2016

Ultra Health's application for the New Mexico True certification is denied by the New Mexico Tourism Department.

June 27, 2016

A medical cannabis caregiver with an infant daughter with a rare form of epilepsy and New Mexico Top Organics-Ultra Health Inc. file a lawsuit against the New Mexico Department of Health (NMDOH) on the basis that the Medical Cannabis Program's 450 plant count is causing direct and immediate harm.

Aug. 16, 2016

Ultra Health arrives to the NM State Fair with a single, 3-week-old seedling cannabis plant at 8:45 a.m. NM State Fair representatives request that Ultra Health suspend its booth at 3:30 p.m. Ultra Health cooperates and removed its booth and seedling at 5:00 p.m. NM State Fair acknowledges they preapproved the booth and offer a full refund for the booth payment.

Sept. 8, 2016

Santa Fe District Judge David K. Thomson orders to stay NMDOH's sanctions against Ultra Health for bringing a single seedling cannabis to the state fair.

April 10, 2017

Raina Bingham, the Director of the Concessions Department for Expo New Mexico, sends an email to Ultra Health containing information on applying to be a vendor at the New Mexico State Fair in 2017.

Jan. 23, 2017

Without prior communication to Ultra Health, Medical Cannabis Program Director Kenny Vigil recommends a sanction of a 5 day cease in operations on the basis that Ultra Health changed the location of its production facility and substantially changed its production plan by bringing a single seedling to the fair.

Sept. 16, 2016

NMDOH threatens to revoke Ultra Health's license in a statement to KRQE News 13 over a music video filmed at Ultra Health's cultivation facility in Bernalillo.

Sept. 9, 2016

Ultra Health submits its application for the NM State Fair in 2017.

April 11, 2017

Bingham sends Ultra Health an email including an extensive list of what Ultra Health will not be able to include in its educational booth at the fair.

May 2, 2017

Ultra Health files a complaint stating Bingham's letter restricts its First and Fourteenth Amendment rights.
