

Aeromexico and Delta Air Lines reinforce connectivity between Mexico and Detroit by launching new route

- May 1, 2019, the airlines will start to serve the route between San Luis Potosi and the Motor City.
- Currently provide flight connections to Detroit from Bajio (Leon), Mexico City, Monterrey, and Queretaro.

Mexico City, MX, Dec. 3, 2018. – Starting May 1, 2019, Aeromexico and its joint cooperation agreement alliance partner Delta Air Lines, will launch service to San Luis Potosi a key market for the automotive industry.
