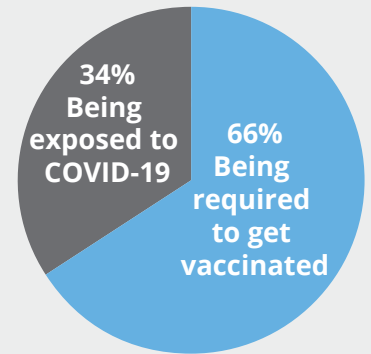


UNVACCINATED AMERICANS: A CLOSER LOOK

The reasons for Americans' concerns about vaccines are well documented. (See de Beaumont Foundation polls and focus groups at www.changingthecovidconversation.org.) To take a closer look at values and attitudes about vaccines and mandates, Morning Consult conducted an August 19-22 poll on behalf of the de Beaumont Foundation with 956 unvaccinated adults. Following are some of the main insights.

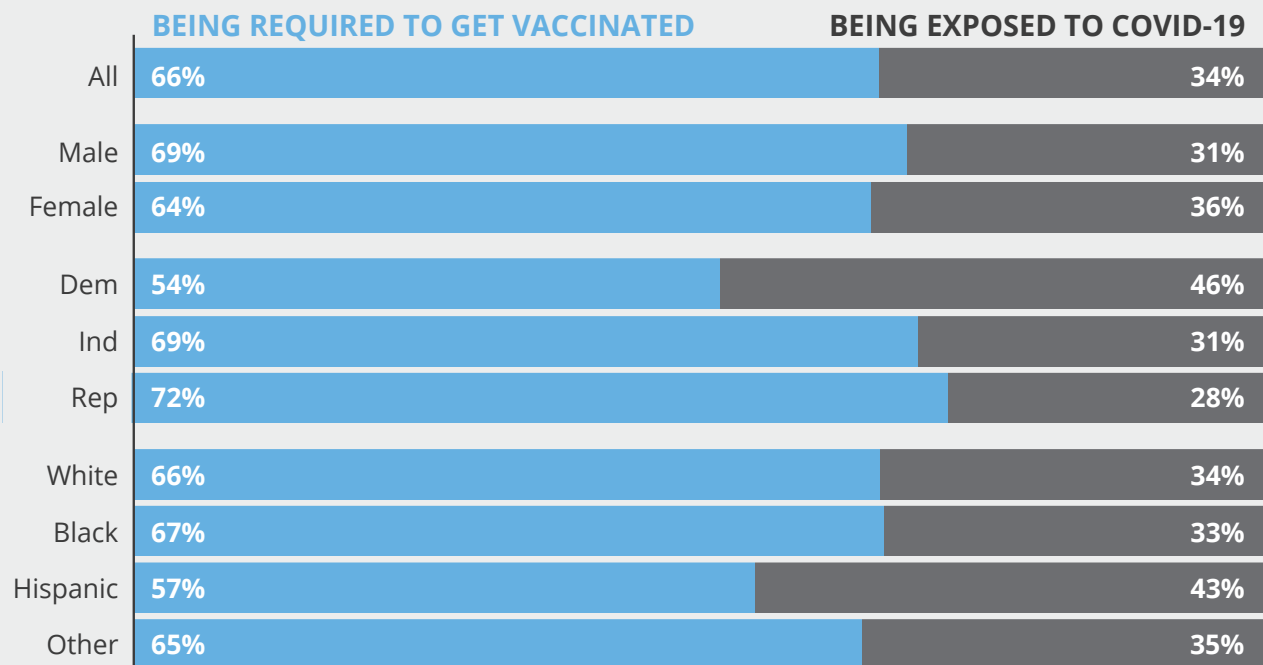

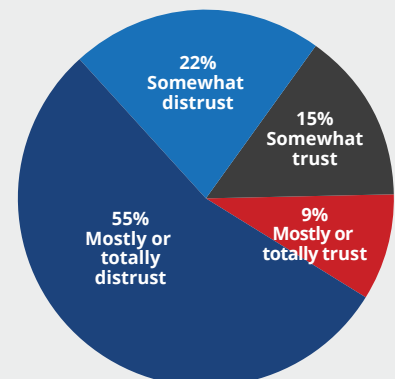
Which is a GREATER threat to your personal health and safety?

- Being required to get a COVID-19 vaccine to enter your workplace or other public spaces such as restaurants, travel, or sporting events.
- Being potentially exposed to COVID-19 when you are in a public space because people decline to get the vaccine.

I DON'T TRUST THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT'S GUIDANCE ABOUT VACCINES.



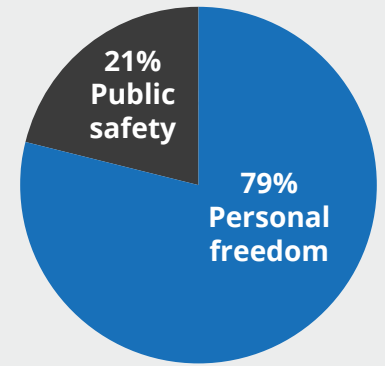
How much do you trust or distrust the federal government's COVID-19 vaccine guidelines?

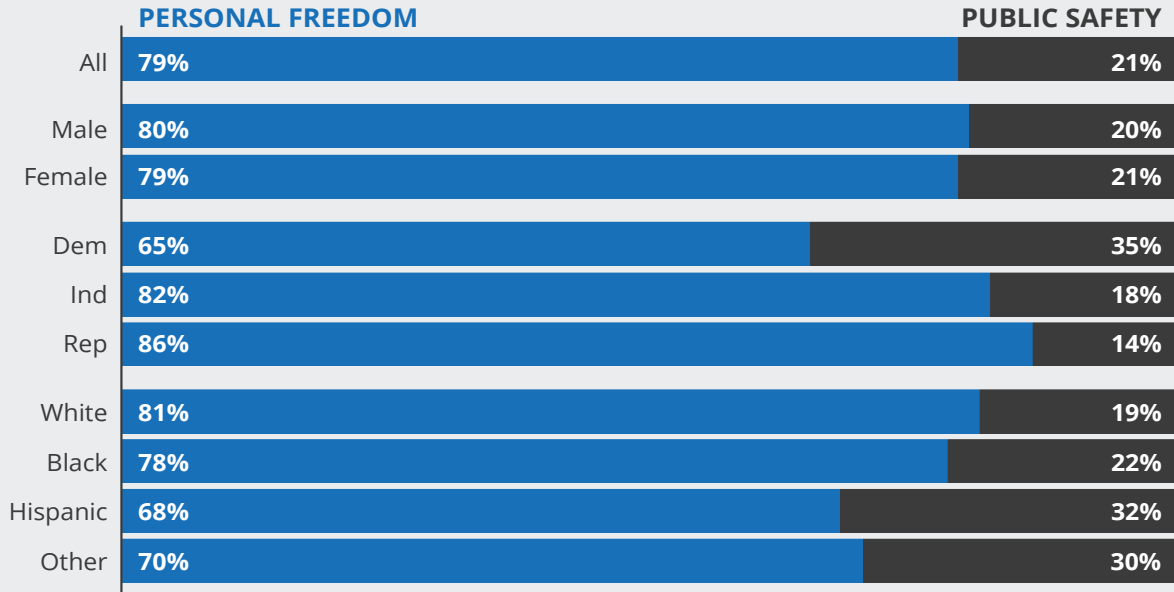

- *Public safety: People should be required to get a COVID-19 vaccine because the virus is highly transmissible and puts people at risk.*

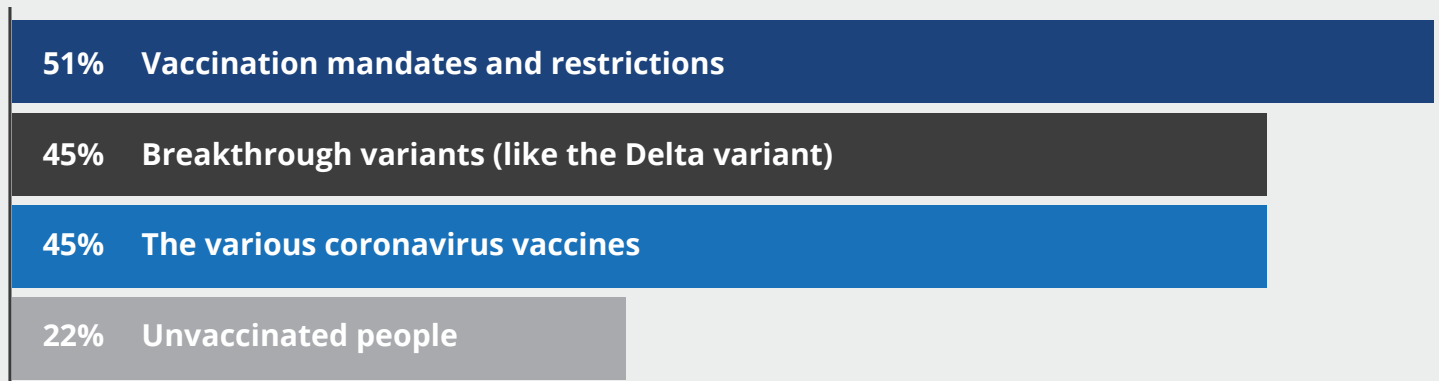

How large of a threat, if at all, are each of the following to your personal health and safety right now? (percentage saying a somewhat large or very large threat)

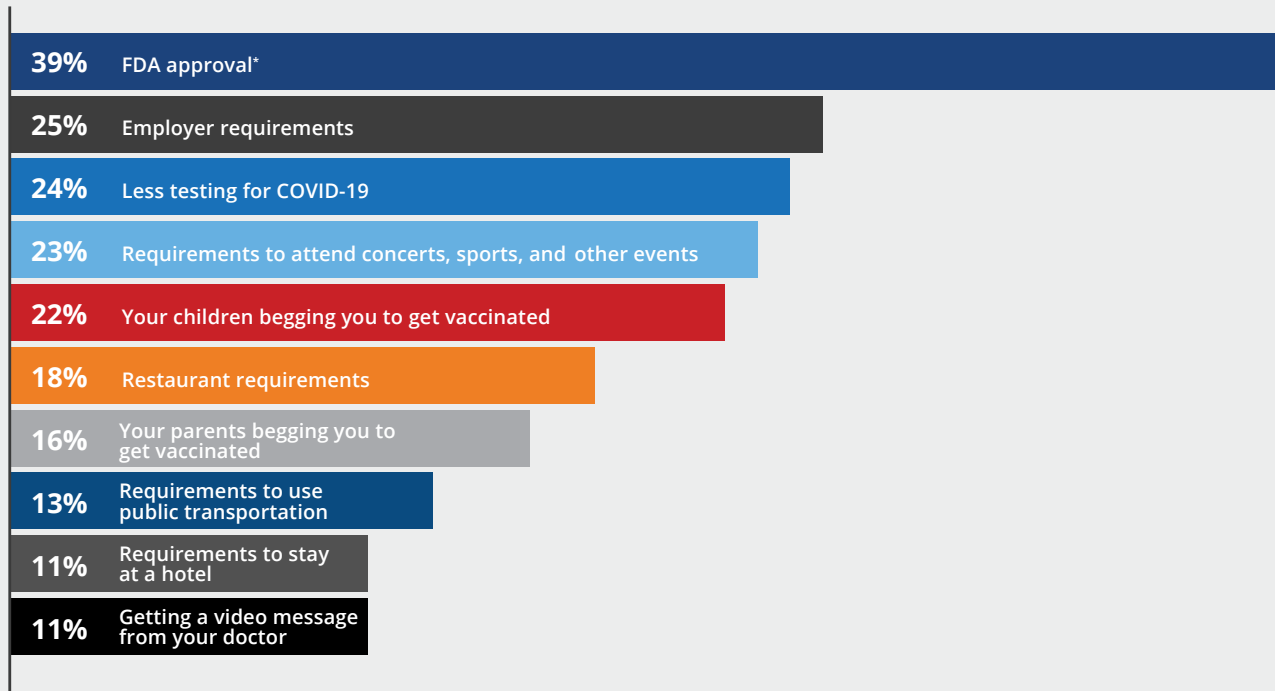
