OVERVIEW

Yamaha Motor Corporation., USA is one of the largest Motorsports manufacturers in the world. Products include All-Terrain Vehicles (ATVs), Side-by-Side (SxS) vehicles, on- and off-road motorcycles, snowmobiles, personal watercraft (PWC), generators, outboard engines, and golf cars.

- The U.S. is the world's largest ATV / SxS market, accounting for more than 70 percent of global sales.
- Yamaha ATV and SxS vehicles are assembled at the Yamaha Motor Manufacturing Corporation of America (YMMC) in Newnan, Georgia, the company's worldwide hub for ATV and SxS production and distribution.
- YMMC produced its 3-millionth vehicle in December 2014 (a Grizzly ATV).
- YMMC produced its 4-millionth vehicle on 8/12/2021 (a Wolverine RMAX2 1000 SxS).
- 2020 marked Yamaha's 65th anniversary and the launch of the all-new Wolverine RMAX 1000 line of recreational SxS vehicles.
