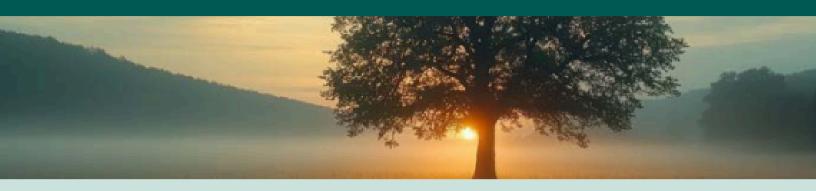

MENTAL HEALTH & SUBSTANCE USE DISORDERS IN AMERICA

More than 1 in 5 adults struggle with mental health—and nearly 1 in 6 battle addiction.

• 48.5 million people aged 12+ had a substance use disorder (SUD) in the past year (17.1% of the population).



• 58.7 million adults aged 18+ experienced a mental illness (22.8% of the population).

The impact is widespread. The need for treatment is urgent.

THE OVERLAP BETWEEN ADDICTION & MENTAL ILLNESS

Mental illness & SUD are deeply connected—treatment must address both.



- 42.4% of adults with any mental illness (AMI) used illicit drugs in the past year.
- Among adults with serious mental illness (SMI), that number jumps to 51.9%.
- In contrast, only 21% of adults with no mental illness used illicit drugs.

Addiction & mental health challenges don't exist in isolation—comprehensive care is critical.

THE TREATMENT GAP: WHO GETS HELP?

Nearly 3 out of 4 individuals in need of treatment didn't receive it.



• 76.4% of people who needed substance use treatment last year did NOT receive it.

Access to care can mean the difference between crisis and recovery.

JAYSON WILLIAMS

FORMER NBA ALL-STAR | FOUNDER OF REBOUND | RECOVERY ADVOCATE

Jayson Williams is a former NBA All-Star, celebrated athlete, and passionate recovery advocate. A standout at St. John's University, he helped lead his team to an NIT Championship and earned MVP honors before being selected in the first round of the NBA Draft by the Philadelphia 76ers. Over his 10-year professional career, he became one of the most dominant rebounders in league history.

Off the court, Jayson faced personal struggles with substance use disorder and trauma, leading him on a journey of reckoning, recovery, and purpose. Determined to rebuild his life, he completed treatment and committed himself to helping others do the same.

In 2015, he founded Rebound, a comprehensive recovery and wellness program endorsed by the NBA as an official resource for players and employees seeking support. As Founder and Lead Visionary, Jayson works alongside those he calls his "Teammates"—not clients—offering personalized therapy, group counseling, life skills development, and holistic wellness therapies.

Jayson's lived experience, resilience, and commitment to second chances have made him a leader and role model in the recovery space. His mission is simple: to help people bounce back stronger than ever and rediscover their true potential.

She previously held executive leadership roles at Futures Recovery Healthcare, Retreat Premier Addiction Treatment Centers, and Onward Behavioral Health, driving business development, strategic expansion, and improved treatment models.

A licensed therapist, Dr. Gilbert has extensive experience facilitating individual, group, and family treatment services. She earned her Doctorate in Counseling Studies from Capella University, her Master's in Counseling Psychology from Chestnut Hill College, and her Bachelor's in Counseling Psychology from Bloomsburg University.



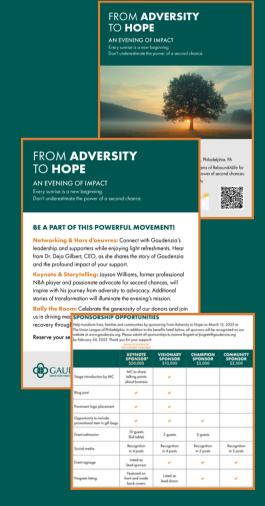

Our History

Gaudenzia was founded in 1968 by a conscientious group of community members who wanted to help themselves and each other overcome the challenges of drug and alcohol use. They soon learned that a collective group was much stronger than an individual, struggling alone.

Over the next 56 years, Gaudenzia began serving those in need of treatment for substance use and co-occurring disorders, becoming one of the nation's first providers with programs designed to meet the needs of pregnant and parenting women, populations affected by HIV/AIDS, and individuals with criminal justice involvement.

Today, Gaudenzia is one of the largest non-profit substance use and co-occurring disorders treatment providers in the northeast United States, serving Pennsylvania, Delaware, Maryland, and the Washington, D.C. areas.

Our Mission

Gaudenzia's mission is to promote long-term recovery by providing comprehensive treatment and support to people with substance use disorder, co-occurring mental health disorders, and related conditions, regardless of individual circumstances.
